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Also on Nov. 8, there will be a statewide vote on Proposition 205, also known as the Arizona Marijuana Legalization Initiative. Proposition 205 is a proposal to allow adults aged 21 and older to possess and to privately consume and grow limited amounts of marijuana, establishes a 15 percent tax on retail marijuana sales (allocating the revenue to public health and education), creates a system in which licensed businesses can produce and sell marijuana, establishes a Department of Marijuana Licenses and Control to regulate the cultivation, manufacturing, testing, transportation, and sale of marijuana, and provides local governments with the authority to regulate and limit marijuana businesses.
