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Also on Nov. 8, there will be a statewide vote on Initiative 732, also known as the Washington Carbon Emission Tax and Sales Tax Reduction. Initiative 732 is a proposal to impose a carbon emission tax on the sale or use of certain fossil fuels and fossil-fuel-generated electricity, at \$15 per metric ton of carbon dioxide in 2017, and increasing gradually to \$100 per metric ton (2016 dollars adjusted for inflation), with more gradual phase-in for some users. It would reduce the sales tax rate by one percentage point over two years, increase a low-income sales tax exemption, and reduce certain manufacturing taxes. Thinking about Proposition 732, which one of the following options would you be most likely to support on Election Day?
